CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please read the conditions of entry in full before entering your works via Trybooking.
The physical Entry Form (find overleaf) is only for members without computer access.

1. Artists must be 2024 GECAG financial members to enter.
2. Three paintings per person may be entered.
3. Paintings must be suitably framed with – NAME, TITLE, MEDIUM, PRICE & GROUP on the back (you can use your own label or use the labels attached to this e-mail with the Entry Form or those on the back bench at the studio).
4. Commission of 25% plus 10% GST on the commission amount is charged by the Flower & Garden Show.
5. Paintings are not insured against theft or damage. The members of the committee and helpers will exercise all reasonable care in handling the artworks submitted but will not accept responsibility for loss or damage whilst in their care. The Committee reserves the right not to exhibit any work deemed unsuitable due to subject, quality, framing or copyright infringement.
6. Use Trybooking to enter your works and pay the entry fees by clicking on:
<https://www.trybooking.com/eventlist/gecag> - select Melbourne International Flower & Garden Show and follow the prompts. (The Password is – **heaven26**). You will be able to enter your painting details online. (If you are unable to pay online, please complete the Entry Form. Leave it in the studio office in the Art Coordinator's tray along with your payment.) Please ensure you note down the details of your entries for your own reference.
7. Entry fee is \$10 for one entry, \$15 for two entries or \$20 for three entries.
8. Paintings must be delivered to the GECAG studio office on or before Friday 15th March 2024. Delivery time on the 15th March is between 12.45 -2.30 pm. Please deliver paintings wrapped for protection and placed into a carry bag.

9. Unsold paintings may be collected from the studio office after Monday 25th March.
10. All paintings must be of flowers or garden themed. No change of Entry Form Information will be accepted after Thursday 15th February.
