

MATERIALS LIST: PEN AND INK

- **A4 or A3 good quality watercolour paper: 300gsm, can be bought in pads or sheets** (*NOT Monte Marte or El Dorado – these brands do not work well with ink*)
- **Hot and Cold pressed paper will be used during classes, so whatever you have, bring along**
- **Drawing paper – 110 gsm - suitable for pen and ink** (won't bleed)
- **Black ink – Waterproof** (*bring along whatever you have*)
- Coloured inks – Waterproof: red, blue and yellow are great starters, (primary colours), but bring along any colours you have.
- *There are many brands of ink, which can be overwhelming. Here are a few that I use and can recommend: Art Spectrum, Winsor & Newton, Sennelier.*
- **Round brushes – sizes 2, 4 & 8** (*bring along any you have. The more the better.*)
- **Flat brush – approximately 4 – 5 cm in width.**
- **Masking fluid** (*not needed for the first few weeks*)
- **HB pencil**
- **Kneadable eraser**
- **Drawing board – A3 size** (*for taping work onto when doing washes*)
- **Waterproof black fine liner pen and / or drawing nib and holder.**
- **Box of tissues** (*these will be used A LOT*)
- **Masking tape**
